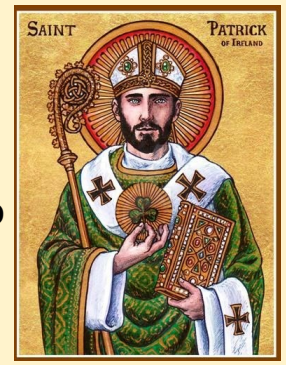

**PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ROME:** 8 Day pilgrimage to Rome 22nd—29th October 2022. Direct flights from Manchester, staying at Hotel Domus Sessoriana. Price £1295 per person (based on two sharing). Single room supplement £185. This cost also includes: a tour manager throughout the pilgrimage; 7 nights at the hotel with breakfast; 7 three course dinners at local restaurants, all transfers in Rome and transport as detailed in the itinerary; entry fees as per itinerary, local guides for Vatican museum, St Peter's, St Paul's, the Catacombs and Christian Rome tour. A sample itinerary is available at the back of church and will include a Papal Audience (subject to the Pope being resident)- there will be one or two small changes such as a visit to the English College where Martin is studying.
